CHILD 1	<p>- Joseph Spencer WEEKS</p> <p>He was a carpenter and wagon maker by trade. He left New York with his folks in 1858-9 and went to Walworth Co. Wisconsin.</p> <p>He enlisted in Co. I, 28th Wisc. Vol. Infantry, and was mustered in on 14 Oct 1862, with Capt. A F Shiverick, 1st Lieutenant Lindsay J Smith, and 2nd Lieutenant Alex T Seymour, as company officers, and with col. James M Lweis, as regimental commander.</p> <p>He was in six hard fought battles besides numerous skirmishes with the rebels, also being on several expeditions which required long tedious marches, and in which they destroyed much stored and captured quantities of arms and ammunition of the enemy. Among some of the battles, being The Battle of Helena, where under command of Lt. Col. Gray with 4,000 men and three batteries of artillery they won a fierce battle against 18,000 or 20,000 men, the next hard battle was near Longview on the Saviné river, where six companies of the 28th Wis. were attacked by 1,500; they checked the rebel force and took 320 rebels prisoners, and the last hard fight of the 28th Wis. being at Spanish Fort near Mobile Alabama, lasting eight or nine days. In this battle the 28th lost five men, two Corporals and three Privates, among them being the men of Co. I, one of which was J Spencer Weeks, who was killed in action, his brother Clark being close beside him at the time, on April 4, 1865, having served his country faithfully and well.</p>
