TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME--GREETING:

Whereas, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at McCloud Minnesota whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the public domain," and the Acts supplemental thereto, the claim of John Dimon

has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the
