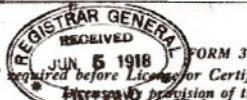

2. The following persons resident in Canada, may be disqualified to contract a marriage between persons not disqualification to contract a

(a) The ministers and every church and religious duly ordained or appointed the rites and ceremonies of denomination to which the belong;

(b) Any elder, evangelist for the time being of any congregation of the religious mostly called or known as "Congregations of God's gations of Christ," and in "Disciples of Christ," who time is chosen by any such for the solemnization of marriage;

(c) Any duly appointed or staff officer of the re called the Salvation Army; missioned by the society to i rriages;

(d) Any elder for the tin church or congregation of r commonly called or known cly as "Farrington Indepen who from time to time is e church or congregation for tion of marriages.

(e) Any recognized evn or elder for the time being gation of Christians comm known as "Brethren," who pointed by any such congt solemnization of marriages, pointment has previously b office of the Provincial Ser

INSTRUCTIONS TO PERSON SOLEMNIZING MARRIAGE.

After solemnizing the marriage, fill in the particulars and forward this LICENSE forthwith to the REGISTRAR GENERAL, Parliament Buildings, TORONTO. (A penalty of \$20.00 is provided for negligence. See "Excerpts.")

if either of the parties is under the legal age of 16 years, the consent of the person whose consent is required must be produced and attached to the above affidavit. (The Marriage Act, Sec. 13.)
 if neither of the parties has resided in Ontario for 15 days immediately preceding the date of this affidavit and the intention has not been advertised, a Permit to Issue must be obtained from the Registrar General. A fee of \$2.00 is charged for such Permit. (See Sec. 10 s. 1, 2 amended.)
 (NOTE.—This law will be varied at the circumstances of the case may require.) 1 Geo. V., c. 32, Form 3.
