KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, Mary E. Cummins and D. W. Cummins her husband, in consideration of Five Dollars, to us paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Samuel Dimson his heirs and assigns, Lot No. 201 in Ramsey Hill Cemetery, in Yamhill County, Oregon, according to the plat thereof of record in the office of the County Recorder of said County, for burial purposes only, said Lot to be subject to such rules and regulations as said grantors may now have or may hereafter be made by them their heirs or assigns.
