HUSBAND - HEZEKIAH WEEKS
 FEB 21, 1755, HE BEING "A MINOR OVER 14 YEARS OF AGE," HE CHOSE AS GUARDIAN. ELIPHALET GAY, A CORDWAINER; ONE OF HIS SURETIES BEING SAMUEL SUTTLESWORTH, OF DEDHAM, BLACKSMITH. HE WAS BOUND AS AN APPRENTICE TO A BLACKSMITH (PERHAPS THE

CHILD 1 - Samuel WEEKS
 HE SERVED IN THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR HIS FATHER FROM 1780 THROUGH AT LEAST 1783, HE WAS ON OF THE GUARD OVER MAJOR ANDRE.

HE WAS A SUCCESSFUL FARMER, AND SUCCEEDED HIS FATHER ON THE SAME FARM, AND LIVED A VERY WORTHY LIFE.
